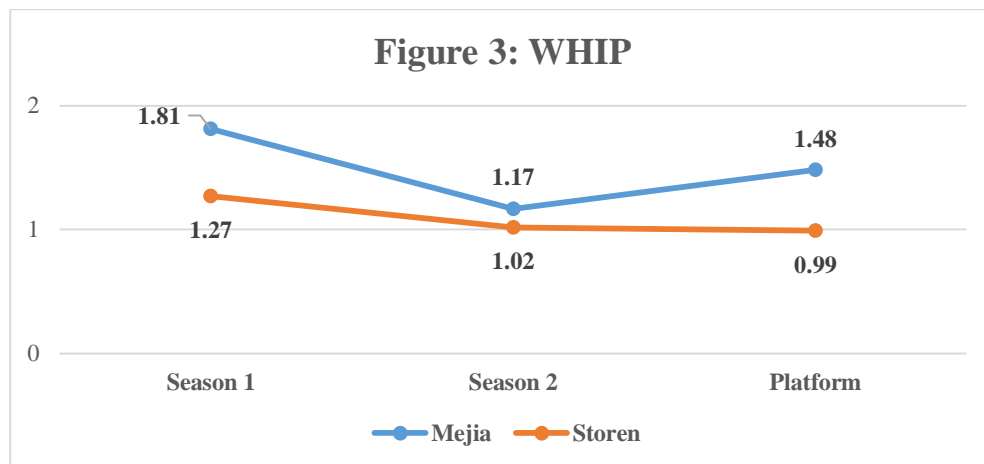
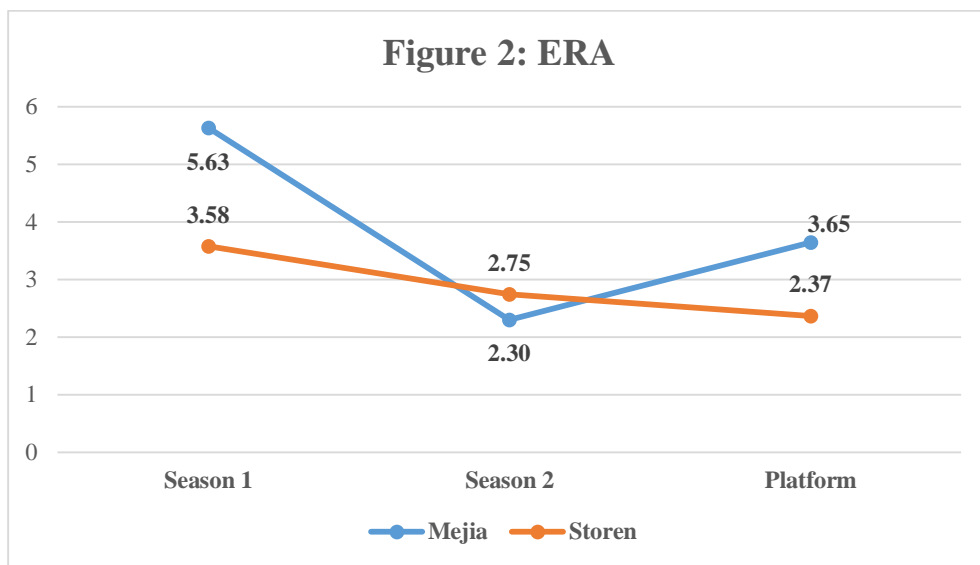
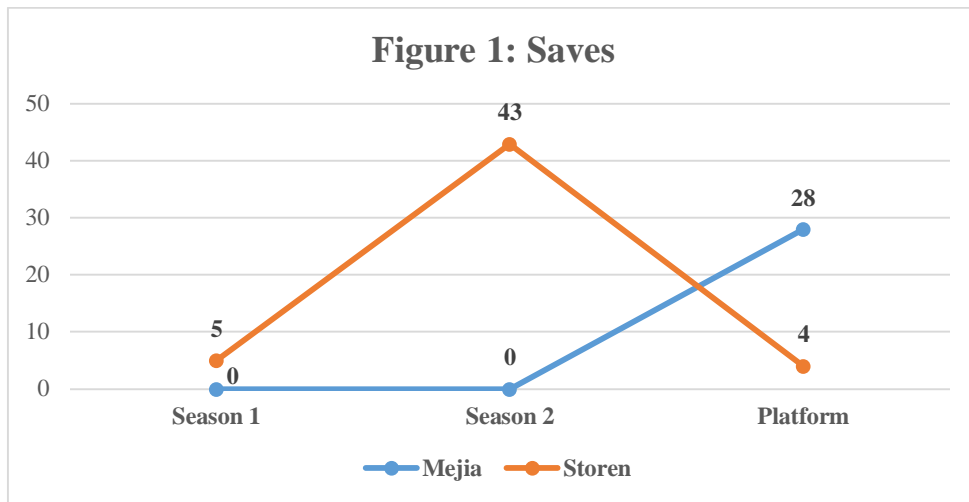


Figure 4: Hits per 9 Innings (H/9)

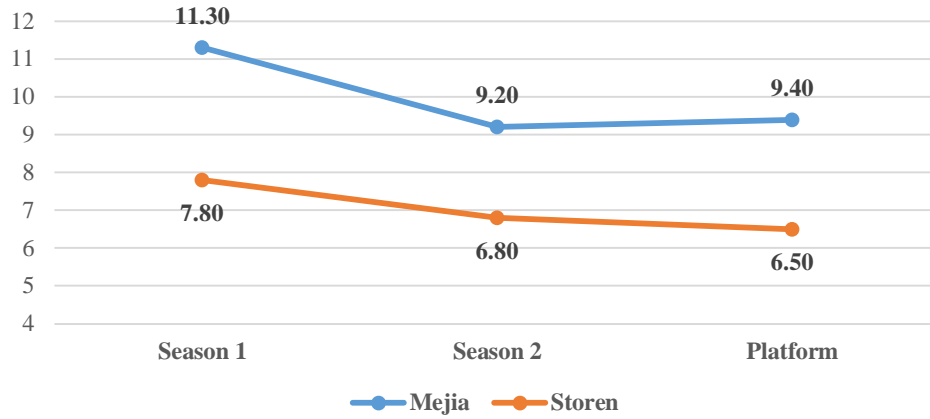


Figure 5: Strikeouts per 9 Innings (K/9)

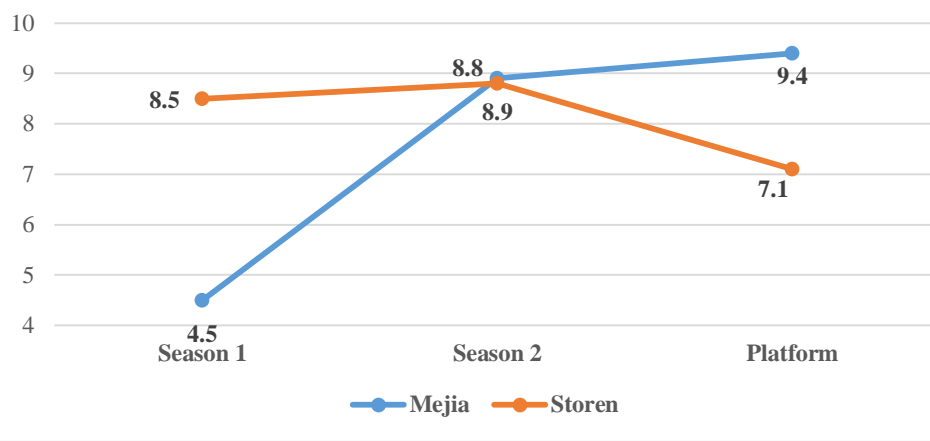


Figure 6: Walks per 9 Innings (BB/9)

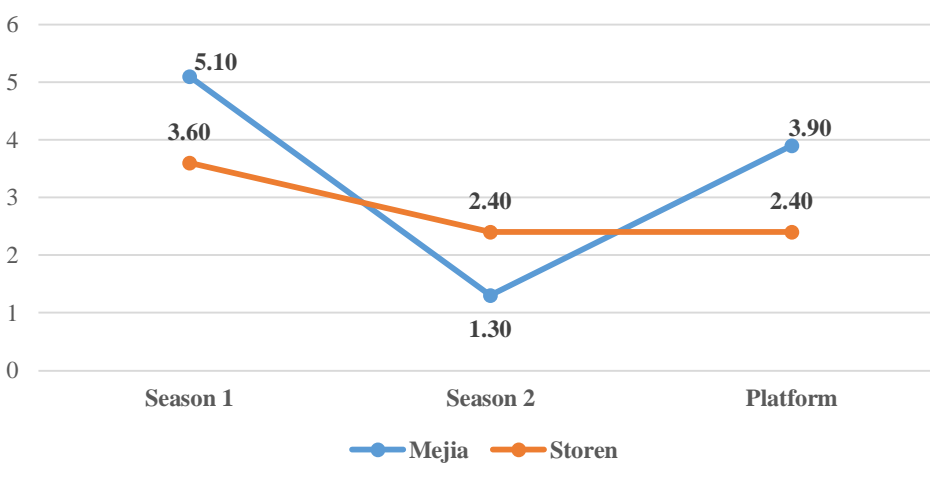


Figure 7: Strikeout to Walk Ratio (SOW)

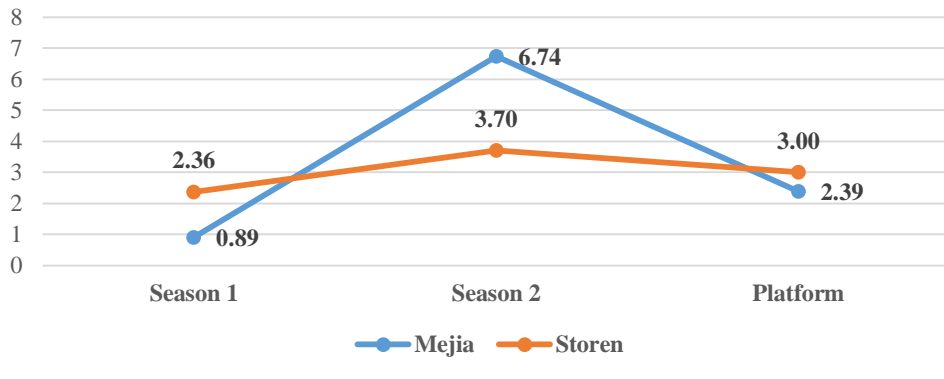


Figure 8: Month to Month Consistency (ERA)

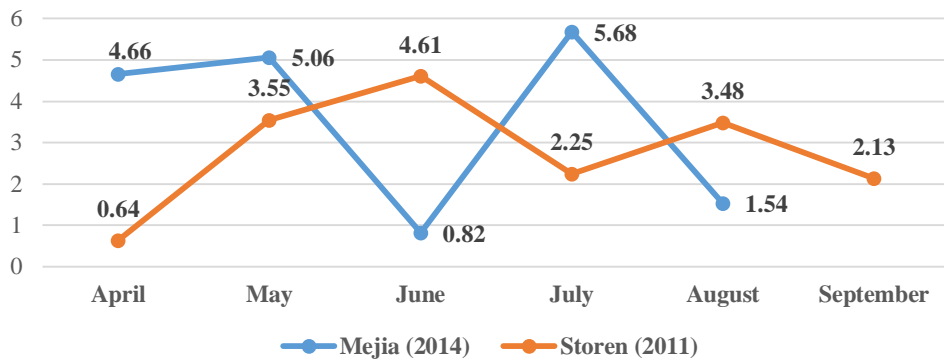

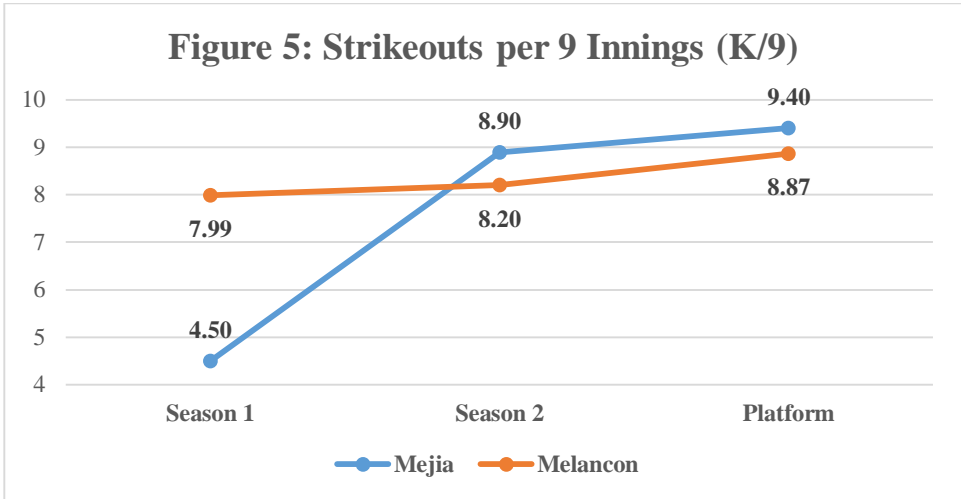
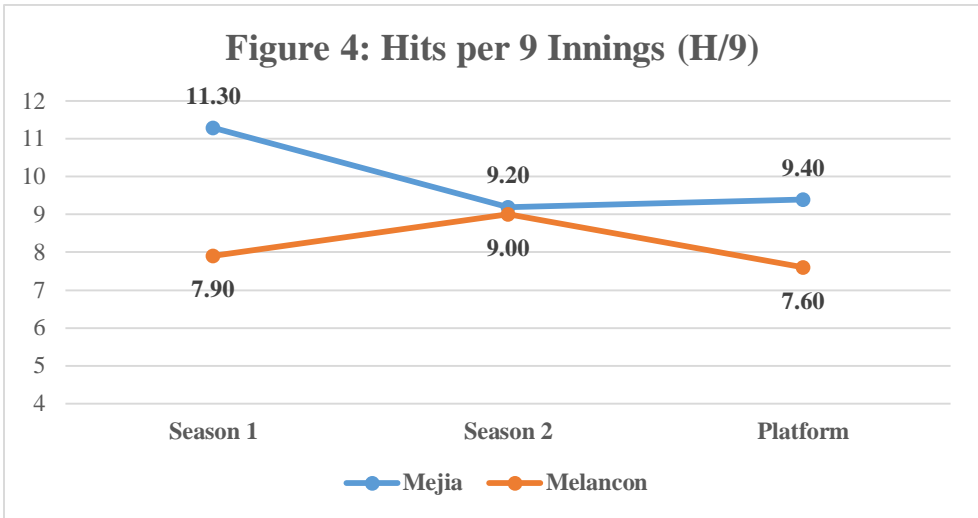
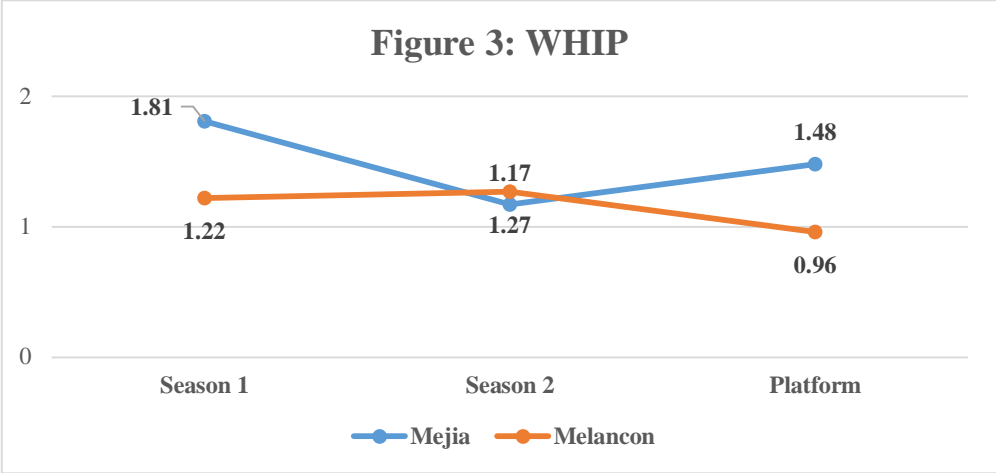


Figure 6: Walks per 9 Innings (BB/9)

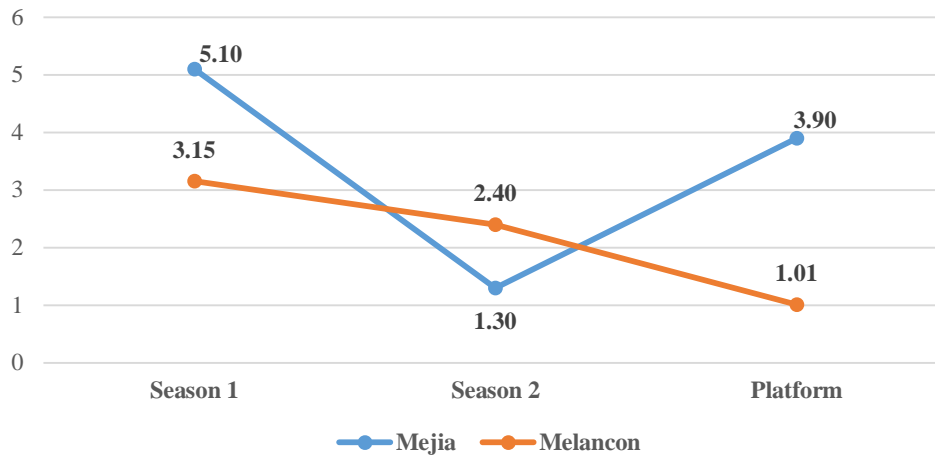


Figure 7: Strikeout to Walk Ratio (SOW)

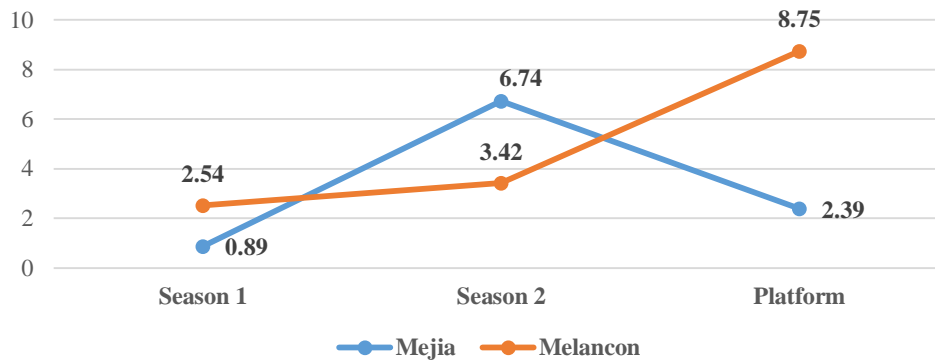


Figure 8: Month to Month Consistency (ERA)

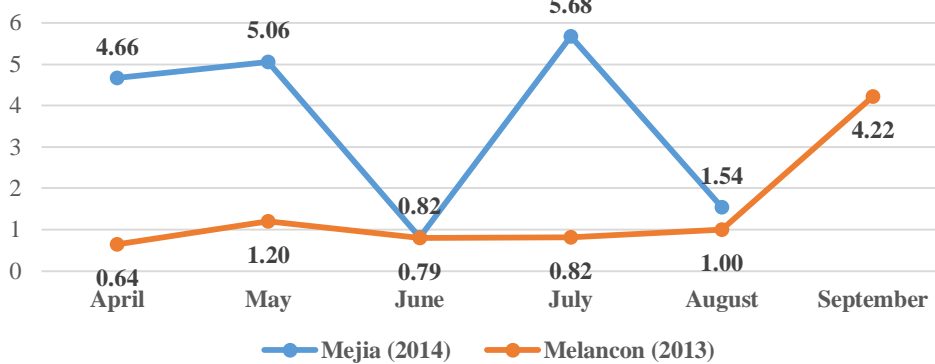

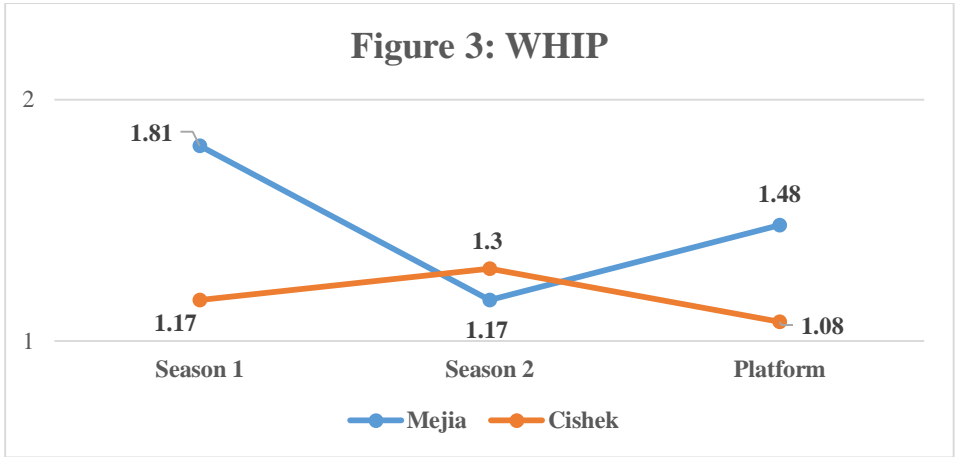
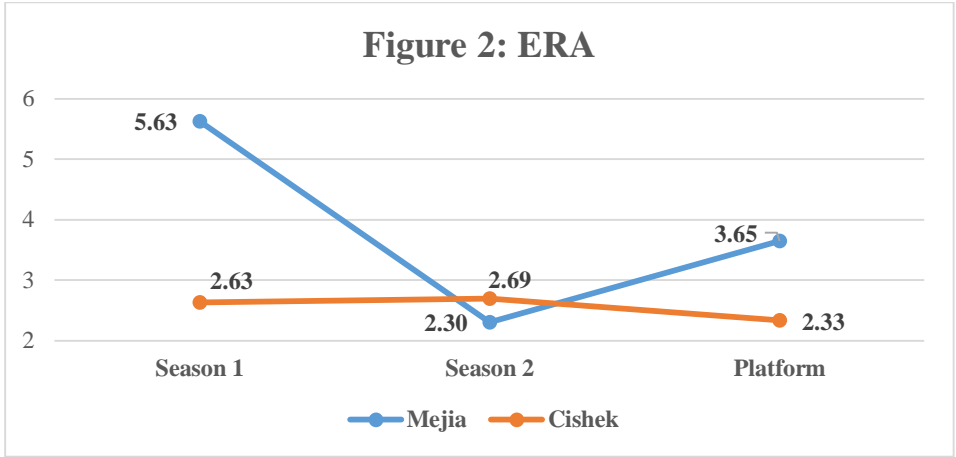
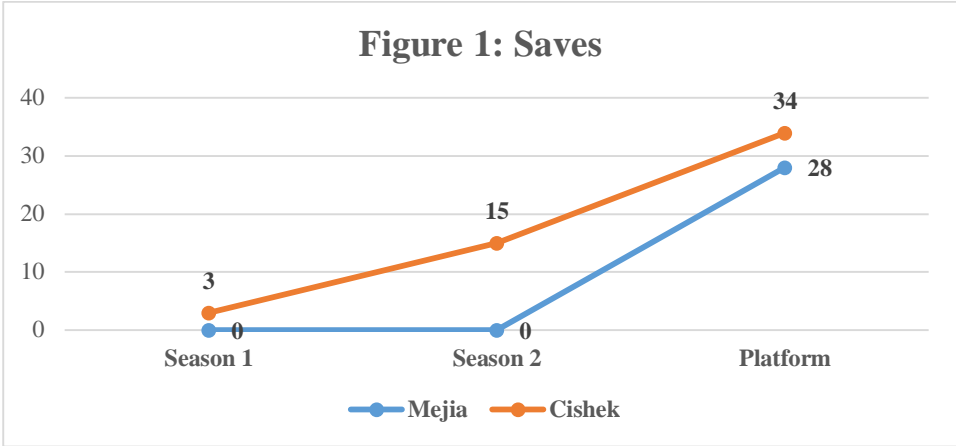


Figure 4: Hits per 9 Innings (H/9)

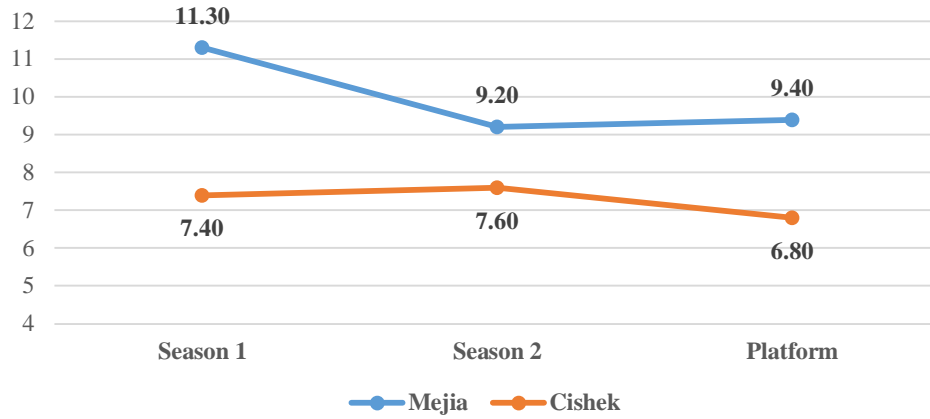


Figure 5: Strikeouts per 9 Innings (K/9)

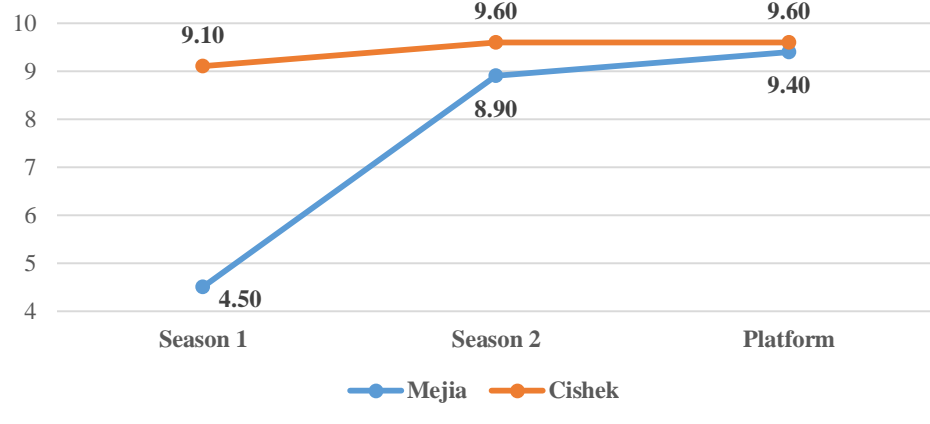


Figure 6: Walks per 9 Innings (BB/9)

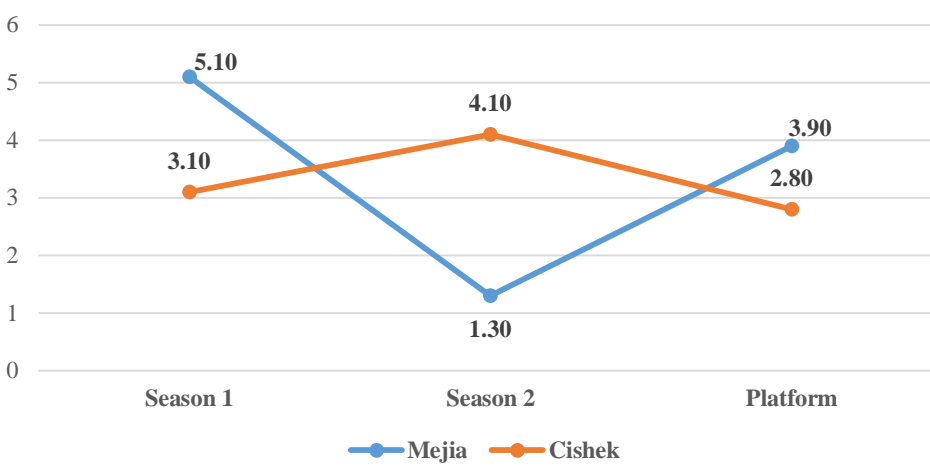


Figure 7: Strikeout to Walk Ratio (SOW)

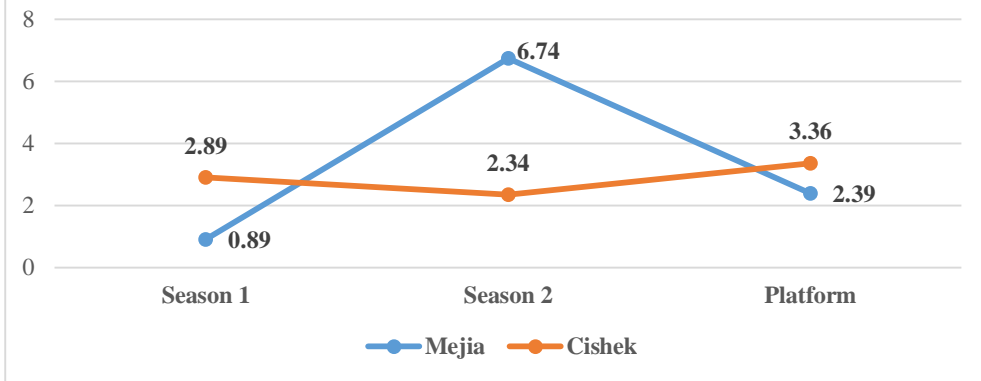


Figure 8: Month to Month Consistency (ERA)

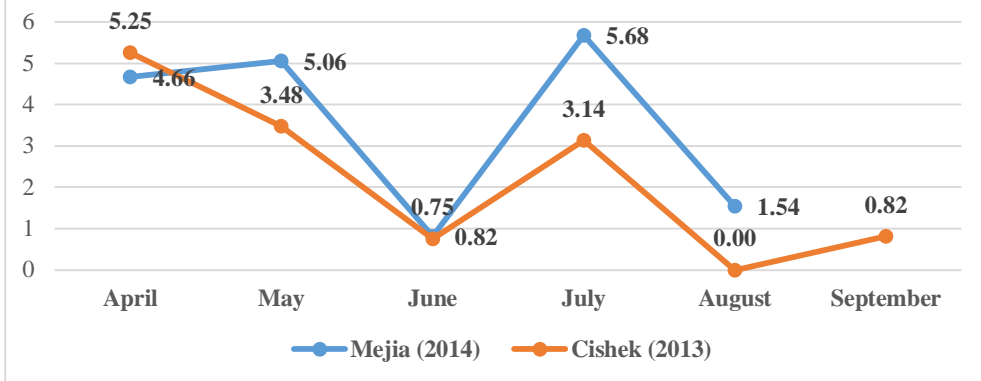

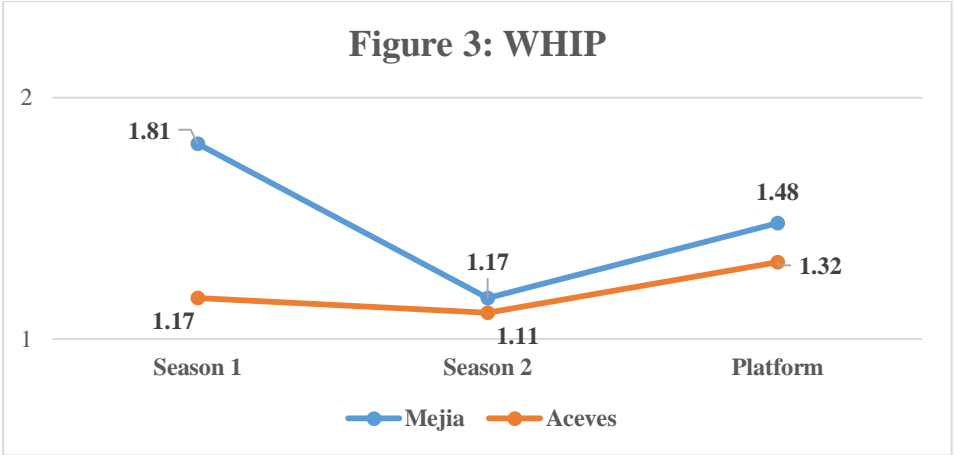
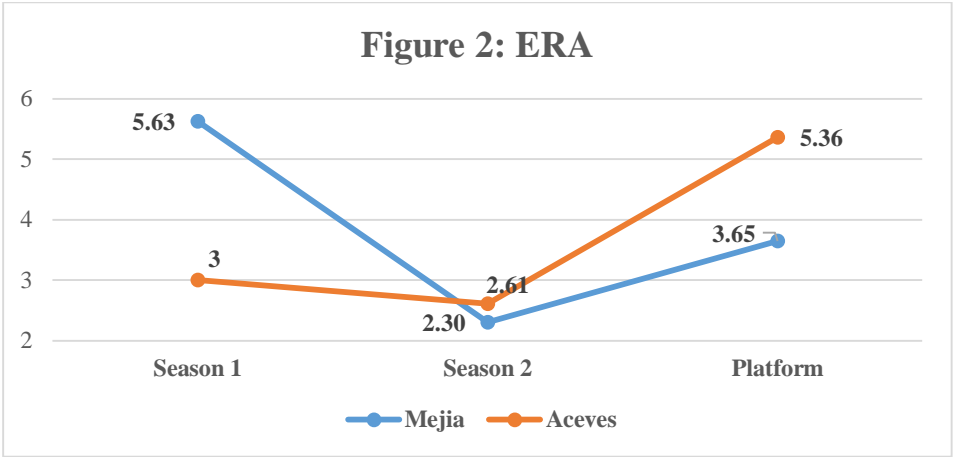
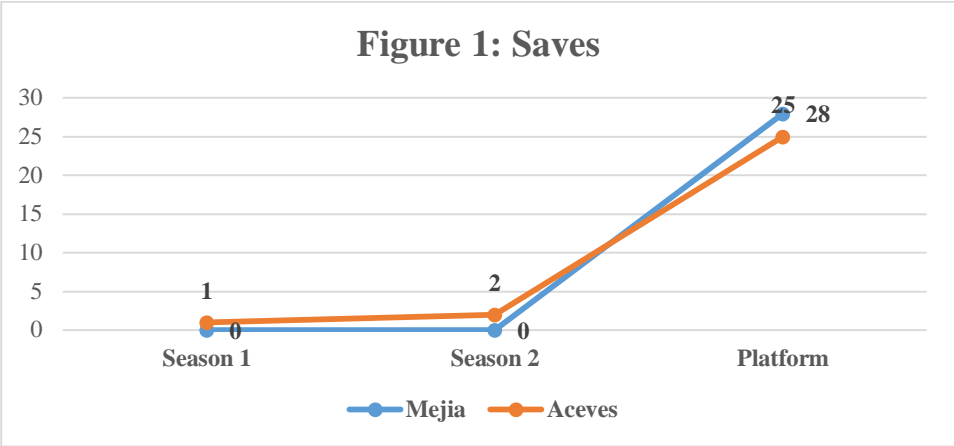


Figure 4: Hits per 9 Innings (H/9)

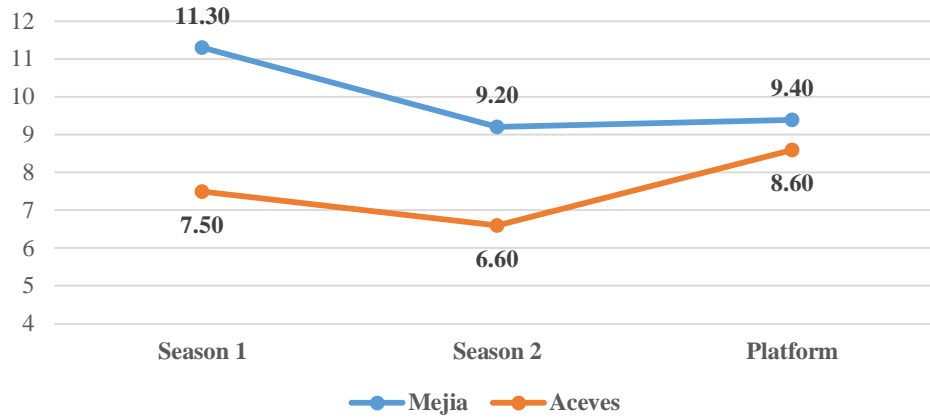


Figure 5: Strikeouts per 9 Innings (K/9)

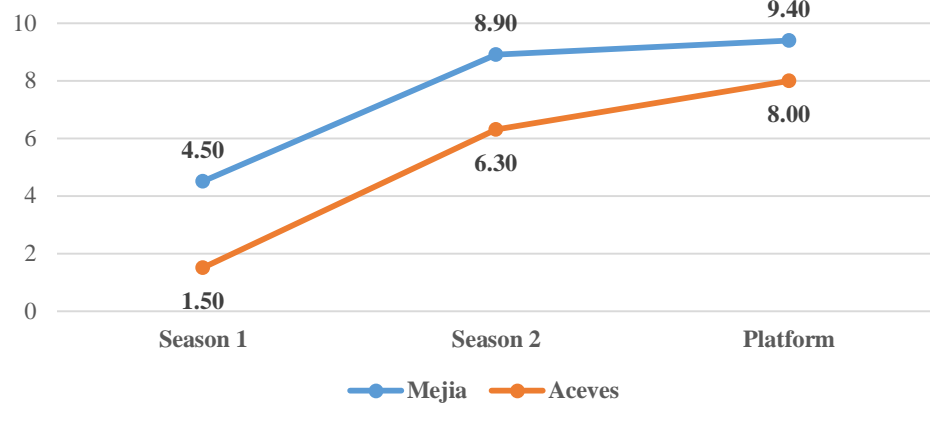


Figure 6: Walks per 9 Innings (BB/9)

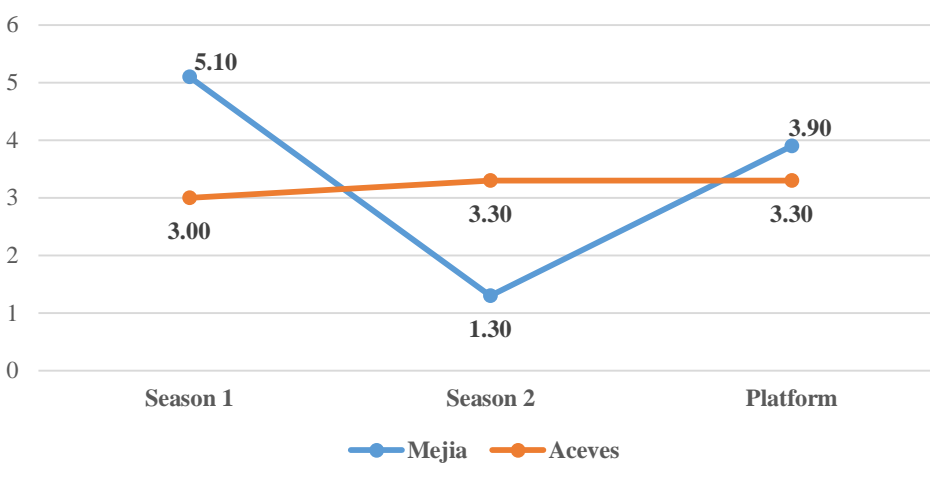


Figure 7: Strikeout to Walk Ratio (SOW)

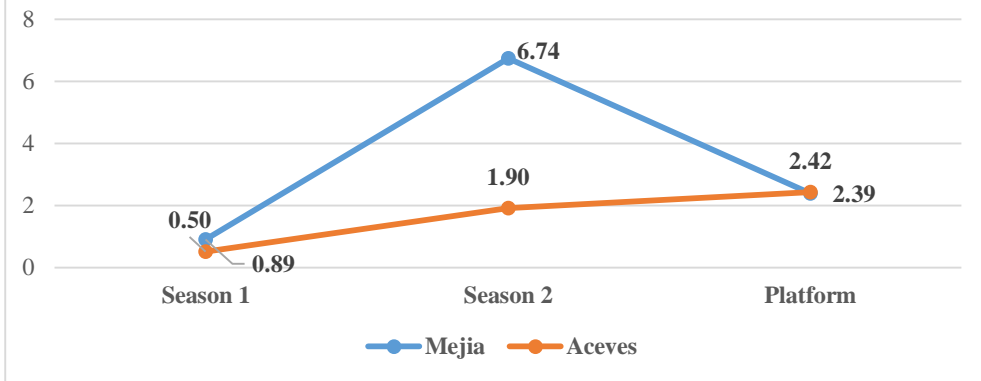


Figure 8: Month to Month Consistency (ERA)

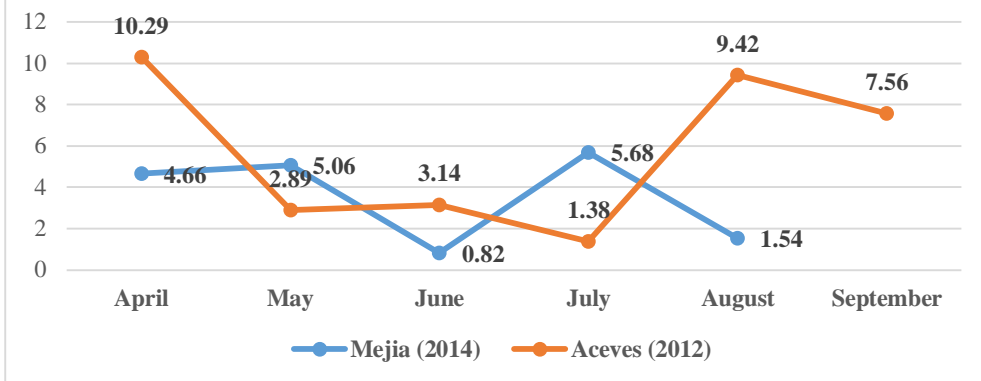

EXHIBIT 9: DEFINITIONS OF ADVANCED STATISTICS

WAR: Wins Above Replacement¹

Wins Above Replacement (WAR) is an attempt by the sabermetric baseball community to summarize a player's total contributions to their team in one statistic. You should always use more than one metric at a time when evaluating players, but WAR is all-inclusive and provides a useful reference point for comparing players. WAR offers an estimate to answer the question, "If this player got injured and their team had to replace them with a freely available minor leaguer or a AAAA player from their bench, how much value would the team be losing?" This value is expressed in a wins format, so we could say that Player X is worth +6.3 wins to their team while Player Y is only worth +3.5 wins, which means it is highly likely that Player X has been more valuable than Player Y.

UZR: Ultimate Zone Rating²

UZR is an advanced defensive metric that uses play-by-play data recorded by Baseball Info Solutions to estimate each fielder's defensive contribution in runs above or below an average fielder at his position in that player's league and year. Thus, an outfielder with a UZR of zero is exactly average as compared to an outfielder in the same year and in the same league. If his UZR is plus, he is above average, and if it is minus, he is below average. There are several different components to UZR, including:

- Outfield Arm Runs (ARM): The amount of runs above average an outfielder saves with their arm by preventing runners to advanced
- Double-Play Runs (DPR): The amount of runs above average an infielder is in turning double-plays
- Range Runs (RngR): The amount of runs above average a player is at getting to balls
- Error Runs (ErrR): The amount of runs above average a player commits for their position

The run values for each of these categories are then compiled into one overall defensive score: UZR.

DRS: Defensive Runs Saved³

DRS is a defensive statistic that rates individual players as above or below average on defense. Much like UZR, players are measured in “runs” above or below average. In simple terms, DRS determine how many more or fewer successful plays a defensive player will make than the league average. For outfielders, DRS takes into account:

- Outfield Arms Runs Saved (rARM): Evaluates an outfielder’s throwing arm based on how often runners advance on base hits and are thrown out trying to take extra bases.
- HR Saving Catch Runs Saved (rHR): Evaluates the number of home run saving catches made by the outfielder
- Good Fielding Plays Runs Saved (rGFP): Recorded when a fielder does something to prevent an advancement or record an out that isn’t typically expect from that position
- Plus Minus Runs Saved (rPM): Evaluates the fielder’s range and ability to convert a batted ball into an out
