

## Judicial Council

Headed by the Interschool AJ, the Judicial Council oversees the appeals process.

Composed of:

- Interschool AJ
- Two 2L Board Members
- Two 3L Board Members

## Moot Court Board

Headed by the Chief Justice, the Board is responsible for the administration of the Moot Court Program. There are two AJs who work directly with the Board: (1) the Academic AJ, who oversees hours requirements, etc.; and (2) the Business AJ, who manages the Moot Court budget.

The Board is composed of:

- Twelve 2L grade-ons;
- 3Ls who graded-on as 2Ls;
- 3Ls who were on Interschool teams as 2Ls;
- 3Ls who were semi-finalists in the Jr. Intrascchool Competition.

## Interschool

Headed by the Interschool AJ, the Interschool Program sends students to compete nationally and internationally each year.

Team members are selected during the fall Argue-on Competition.

Team members participate in regular practices and receive 1 academic/team.

## Invitational

Headed by the Invitational AJ, this branch runs the various competitions that Tulane Moot Court hosts each year.

## Intrascchool

Headed by the Intrascchool AJ, the Intrascchool Program allows students compete individually against their classmates.

2L and 3L students advance through three rounds of competition to determine a class champion.

Students do not attend practices or receive academic credit.
