By selecting “Will Not Require Housing in Rio” on the Tulane Summer Abroad application form for Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, students who do not wish to stay at the Jucati are accepting the following terms, releasing Tulane and its affiliates from liability with regard to the student’s accommodation:

By declining housing in Rio, I hereby affirm that I do not want Tulane University Law School’s summer program in Rio de Janeiro to make arrangements for my housing while attending the course in the city of Rio de Janeiro. By submitting the application form, I hold Tulane University Law School and its employees and agents harmless from any and all responsibility or liability whatsoever relating to the housing I obtain by myself or together with others. In addition, I understand that by submitting this application, Tulane University Law School’s summer program in Rio de Janeiro will not be expected to provide me with any assistance in obtaining housing or in resolving any concerns or problems related to the housing I obtain.
